Ruah Legal Services and the Mental Health Law Centre provides an innovative Care and Protection Service that brings together experienced lawyers and dedicated community Key Workers to provide wrap-around legal and non-legal social support to families facing child protection proceedings.

You will be assigned a dedicated team who will support you and advocate on your behalf for the full duration of your Care and Protection proceedings involving the Department of Communities.

We can provide help with:

- Legal advice and representation in court
- Representation and support at pre-birth meetings
- Attending appointments with the Department of Communities and other out-of-court meetings
- Identifying and providing support to help you achieve your goals
- Linking you to other relevant support services.
